Journey overview

&Beyond Ngala Private Game Reserve is situated within the western boundary of the world-renowned Kruger National Park, at the heart of the South African lowveld. This is one of the richest wildlife regions on the continent, with a great diversity of large and spectacular wildlife. Elephant, lion, leopard, cheetah, buffalo and white rhino are all common and are extremely relaxed when approached by vehicles, allowing for unsurpassed game viewing and photographic opportunities. Eagles, vultures, hornbills, rollers, owls, woodpeckers and starlings are among the best represented bird families.

Activities at **&Beyond Ngala** are centred around game viewing drives in open vehicles, which traverse an area of some 14,700 hectares (36,500 acres) in search of wildlife, including nocturnal species that are viewed after sunset. Guided walks are a highlight for those wanting even closer contact with this magnificent African wilderness. Specialist Safaris available at **&Beyond Ngala** include birding, photographic and walking adventures as well as participative rhino notching.

In the heart of the Delta, on the edge of a waterway, you'll find **Sandibe Okavango Safari Lodge**. Situated on a diverse, wildlife-rich private concession, Sandibe has exclusive traversing rights over a vast 22,500 hectares (55,600 acres) of wildlife land bordering the Moremi Game Reserve. The inspired organic design of the lodge melts into the surrounding forest canopy of wild palms. Gnarled fig trees will shade you as you approach the lodge; an intriguing curl and sweep of shingled wood comes into view, resembling a giant scaled pangolin at rest. Stairs open onto the high ceilings of the copper-toned and glassless guest area overlooking the Delta. From this central dining area, the wooden deck stretches beyond the roof, while the upstairs bar and lounge extend along an elevated walkway to a viewing platform.

A series of decks descend to the forest floor culminating in a log boma, with a small gym and private massage sala close by. Interior finishes throughout showcase the craftsmanship of Botswana's artisans, and feature intricate basketware, sculpted wooden tables and unique feature pieces. While the main guest area is set within the forest, the twelve guest suites peep out from beneath its canopy. Raised above the papyrus-lined banks like golden weaver nests, each is a cocoon of privacy, with breathtaking views, a private plunge pool and cosy fireplace.

Perfectly positioned within an exclusive 25,000-hectare wilderness concession, **&Beyond Xaranna Okavango Delta Camp** boasts breathtaking views out over a permanent channel of the Okavango Delta. The overall atmosphere of the Camp is cool, light and airy, in keeping with its gentle geographic location on



the Delta. The nine sleek ensuite safari tents are organic in design with a combination of canvas and bleached timber, delicately decorated in shades of fatigue (khaki) and soft lily pink. Each tent boasts a romantic sala, private plunge pool, indoor bathtub and al fresco shower. The guest areas are all positioned carefully to maximise the sweeping views out across the channels. The intimate guest sitting area boasts a spacious reading area, perfect for afternoon relaxation. The elevated dining area features shady verandas with mesmerising views leading out onto an open air boma, where exotic candlelit dinners are served under the stars. A fully stocked Safari Shop offers chic safari gear, African art and jewellery.

Tucked under a canopy of mopane and tamboti trees, Ngala Safari Lodge boasts 20 thatched Cottages, including three Family Cottages with interleading doors, and one three-bedroom Family Villa. Each of the spacious ensuite Cottages exudes a romantic ambience with nostalgic, classic safari memorabilia throughout. Floor-to-ceiling glass windows make the most of sunny safari days and a private veranda offers the perfect setting for intimate dinners. Family Cottages can accommodate two adults and two children, while the gracious Family Villa accommodates four adults and two children and includes access to a private swimming pool and the use of a private vehicle.

The lodge's rim-flow swimming pool and sundeck overlook a natural riverine woodland, ideal for avid birdwatchers, while a tranquil massage sala and a well-equipped gym can be enjoyed in between game drives. Dinners are set in a candlelit courtyard or showcased as an African feast in the open-air boma.

Ngala Private Game Reserve shares unfenced borders with the world-renowned Kruger National Park, nearly 2 million hectares (4.9 million acres) of unrivalled wilderness and wildlife land, home to the Big Five and more species of large mammals than any other African game reserve. Here we have a chance to see White lions - there are only five White Lions in the wild on the entire planet and four of them are resident on Ngala's Private Concession. This, in addition to seeing a wild dog hunting pack, makes this a fantastic safari destination that never disappoints!

Day 1 ARRIVE CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the Winchester Mansions Hotel situated along the South Atlantic Sea Front in Green Point, close to everything that makes Cape Town such a wonderful place to visit. This hotel sets itself apart from other hotels in and around Cape Town with its spectacular location, stylish elegance, and personalized service.

Day 2 CAPE TOWN FULL DAY CAPE POINT TOUR

After breakfast you will enjoy a full day tour of Cape Point where the Indian and Atlantic Oceans meet. Your tour today includes Hout Bay, Cape Point Nature Reserve, Cape Point observatory, Cape of Good Hope, a visit to the penguin colony of Simonstown and a visit to Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. The tour will stop in a quaint fishing village where we have arranged for a lovely seaside lunch for you at Bertha's Restaurant overlooking the harbor and yacht marina.

MAY 6, 2026 Today your South African Wine and Safari Odyssey begins. If you have opted to participate in our pre-Safari Cape Town Package you will be collected from your hotel mid-morning for transfer to the Winelands. If you are arriving by air today, you will be met upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport and brought to the 5-Star Lanzerac Hotel & Spa in the heart of South Africa's Premier Wine Region. If you have booked the prepackage tour of Cape Town, you will be met at the Hotel for a mid-morning transfer to Lanzerac Hotel & Spa. The balance of the day will be at leisure.

Experience 3 nights at Lanzerac Hotel & Spa. Located just outside the historic wine- farming town of Stellenbosch and nestled in the foothills of the Jonkershoek Mountains. Steeped in a history dating back to 1692, the Estate offers dramatic mountain views, endless rows of lush vineyards and hectares of landscaped gardens shaded by giant oak trees. This iconic five-star hotel provides an unparalleled experience of luxury in the Western Cape winelands.

This afternoon, relax at the hotel, take a walk through the vineyards, indulge in the Spa's hydro facilities, or enjoy a complimentary wine tasting of five Lanzerac Estate wines at the Lanzerac Tasting Room. The hotel has a stunning restaurant - the Governor's Hall - and we suggest making a reservation here for dinner tonight. Otherwise, the hotel offers a shuttle into the town of Stellenbosch, where many restaurants can be found.

May 7, 2026 After a leisurely breakfast, depart for a full day exploring the magnificent wine region. We head to the Franschhoek Valley for our first stop at one of the oldest wine estates in the country, *La Motte* - with superb examples of Cape Dutch architecture dating back to the early 18th century. Enjoy a sampling of the wines produced on the estate and a look at the La Motte heritage collection of art works by South Africa's most acclaimed landscape artist, *J.H. Pierneef*. Lunch today will be on the *La Petite Ferme* wine farm, with unrivalled views down on the Franschhoek Valley.

After lunch, a stroll around the Franschhoek village is a must - historic buildings, art galleries, boutique stores offer something of interest to everyone. On our return drive to Stellenbosch, we stop in at another fine wine estate in the shadow of the Simonsberg mountains, with a rich history dating back to 1700's. Return to the hotel late afternoon for an evening at leisure.

May 8, 2026 We depart after breakfast for another unforgettable vineyard day. First up will be the *Rust en Verdi*, a Stellenbosch estate that has a history going back 320 years, and which produces only top-end red wines, with the focus on Syrah, Cabernet and Merlot. Then it is on to the *Clos Malverne* estate for a food and wine pairing Lunch in the acclaimed restaurant.

We return to the hotel in the mid-afternoon. Tonight, please plan to join John for dinner.

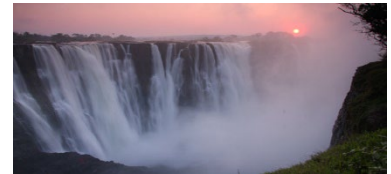
